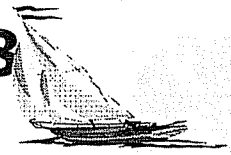

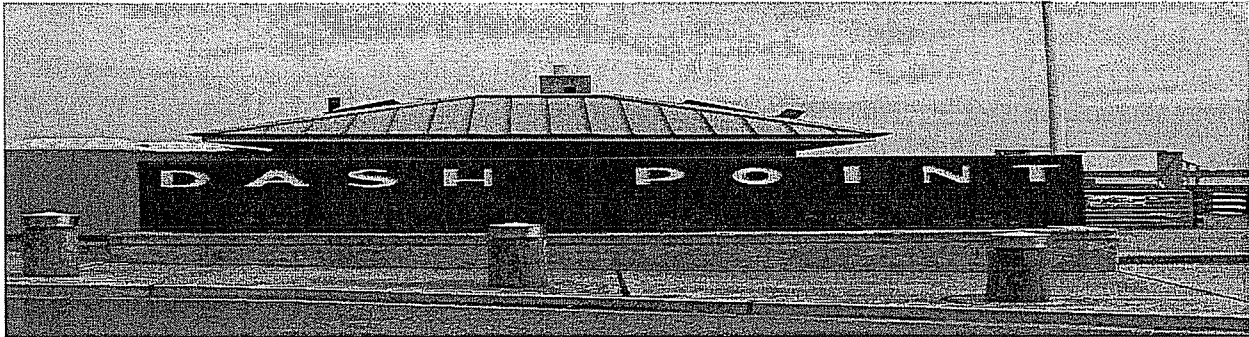

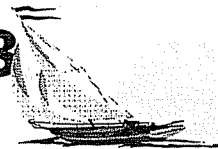

Seabury Update

Transition and transformation best describe events at Seabury School as it enters its 19th year in the Dash Point / Brown's Point community. Seabury is growing and thriving, serving students in Northeast Tacoma and throughout the South Puget Sound region.

Last spring, Seabury's Board of Trustees announced a plan to develop an innovative middle school program that will once again allow Seabury to serve students from preschool through eighth grade. The Seabury community is proud to announce that Toby Welch, founder and former head of The Harbor School on Vashon Island, has joined Seabury's staff as planning teacher for the middle school. Toby will be working with staff, parents, students and community members to develop the middle school program and curriculum. Plans include working closely with the community, which will serve as an extension of the classroom. Experiential learning and community service will be the hallmarks of Seabury middle school, which is already gaining recognition from community leaders. This summer has also seen a transformation for Seabury's youngest students. Seabury parent and local interior designer and artist Margaret Jacobsen has transformed Seabury's Early Learning Center classroom into a Pacific Northwest habitat complete with Mount Rainier, a leaping orca, and animals peeking out of the forest canopy. Working with parent volunteers, Jacobsen, a designer whose projects have included Street of Dreams homes, has covered the walls of the classroom with vibrant murals reminiscent of the northwest landscape. Three and four year olds in the Early Learning Center will be immersed in the natural world as they explore, learn and grow together. You are invited to stop by and take a look!

Finally, Summer at Seabury is in full swing. Seabury students and children from the community are taking part in camps ranging from crypto zoology to acting for film to model rocketry. Taught by Seabury teachers as well as local teachers and artists, Summer at Seabury camps have become a summer tradition for many families in the community.
